NDMU offers classes throughout Southern Maryland—Calvert, Charles, and St. Mary's.

NDMU offers local advisement. Our offices are located in Southern Maryland. Ask about scheduling an appointment. Email and phone advisements are also available.

NDMU allows students to register for up to 6 credits before acceptance to a program is required.

NDMU provides learning environment options: face-to-face, online, and self-paced courses. The program of study determines how many learning environment options are available for a given program.

NDMU offers professional-friendly scheduling. Typical scheduling:

- 4 Saturdays, all day
- 7 weeks, one evening per week
- 13 weeks, one evening per week

NDMU has rolling admissions. With the exception of the doctoral program, there are no application deadlines. Apply at any time!
